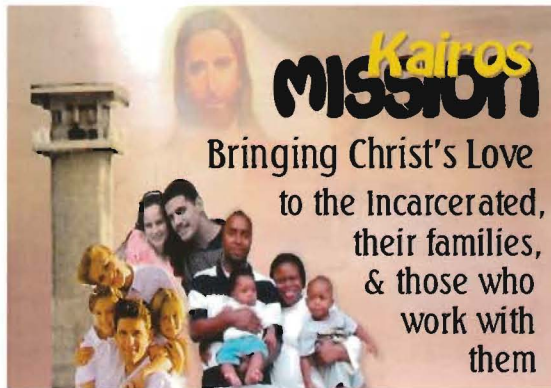

"I had lost everything that I ever loved because of what I had done. But because of Kairos, I now know that Jesus loves me and that makes all the difference."

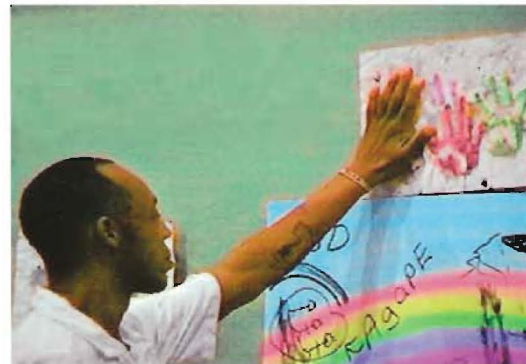
How to Respond to Christ's Call

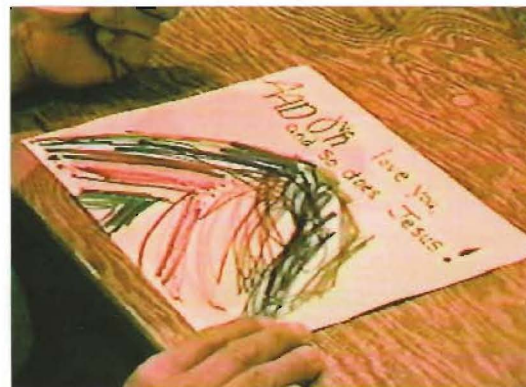
Posters
